Minutes of Previous Meeting

Community Engagement

The most recent survey largely supports the direction of travel of the proposed Neighbourhood Plan and 165 responses was a decent return.

The main issue arising was the distribution of houses as follows:

13 on Site 606, 6 on Site 579 and 9 on Site 143.

We support the distribution weighting. If Site 143 can only support 9 as per their indicative layout we would then most likely redistribute the remainder on Site 606 as it is the preferred site.

Following on from the survey results Trevor will draft a report to be forwarded to Peter Bull. This will help to formulate the Neighbourhood Plan.

We need to establish that the Village Design Statement has been instigated.

This will appear as an Appendix to the Neighbourhood Plan.

Next Steps

- a) Draft Neighbourhood Plan. We are waiting a final quotation from Peter Bull which will be circulated to HPC for approval prior to the September meeting.
- b) Strategic Environmental Assessment. This cannot be instigated until we have a draft Neighbourhood Plan.
- c) Habitats Regulations Screening Assessment. As above cannot be actioned as yet.
- d) Village Design Statement. Trevor will make contact with Jonathan Duck regarding timescales. (Now done).

Any Other Business

- a) Planning Consultant Proposed Fees.

Quote to be circulated via email to HPC as stated above. A timeline for this work will be required.

b) Catesby Estates

Decision on this proposed development was not made within a timeframe Catesby deemed reasonable. It has now gone to the Planning Inspectorate but will also go before BBC on 19/8. HPC have a 5 minute slot to speak if they so wish. Robbin will circulate to see if anyone wishes to attend.
