Regulation 9 of the SEA Regulations requires the responsible authority to produce a statement of its reasons for the determination and to consult relevant consultation bodies. You are invited, therefore, to consider the SEA Screening Report and Draft Neighbourhood Plan and to respond to the Parish Council.
